FINAL JUDGMENT

Plaintiff, the Federal Trade Commission, having commenced this civil action by filing its Complaint herein for alleged violation of Paragraphs II.A. and IX.B. of the Decision and Order issued by the Federal Trade Commission on February 15, 2018, and of Paragraphs II.A., II.B. and II.D. of the Order to Maintain Assets issued by the Federal Trade Commission on December 15, 2017,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

I.

The Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter herein and each of the parties consenting hereto. The Complaint asserts claims upon which relief can be granted against Defendants under Section 5(a) and 16(a)(1) of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 45 and 56(a)(1).

II.

Judgment is hereby entered upon Stipulation, in settlement of disputed claims, in favor of the Plaintiff, the Federal Trade Commission, and against Defendants without trial or adjudication of any issue of fact or law herein. Defendants shall comply with the provisions of this Final Judgment.

III.

Defendants shall pay to the Federal Trade Commission a civil penalty in the amount of three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) which shall be paid and delivered in the following manner:

- A. Payment shall be made within thirty (30) days after entry of this Final Judgment;
- B. Payment shall be made by wire transfer of funds to the Federal Trade Commission pursuant to

This Final Judgment resolves all of the allegations in the Complaint. Entry of this Final Judgment is in the public interest.
