On October 8, 2024, Express Scripts, Inc., Evernorth Health, Inc., Medco Health Services, Inc., and Ascent Health Services LLC ("ESI Respondents")¹ moved to disqualify Chair Lina M Khan, Commissioner Alvaro M Bedya, and Commissioner Rebecca Kelly Slaughter from participating in the above captioned matter.
